PDGA Current Membership	Required	Recommended for 2019, Required for 2020
TD & Officials requirements	TD and any listed Assistant TD(s) must be current PDGA member and current certified PDGA Official. TD and Assistant TD must be non-playing. Minimum one non-playing official per course.	
Length of event	2 to 4 days	
Minimum number of holes played	54 for all players. At event's discretion, an additional final may be played (minimum 9 holes).	
Divisions	MPO and FPO divisions required	
	MP40, FP40, MP50, MP60, MJ18, FJ18, MA1 and FA1 are optional.	
Estimated Pro attendance	72 - 120 players	36 - 72 players
Estimated Amateur attendance	0 - 48 players	36 - 72 players
Player grouping	Players may be grouped randomly for the 1 st round only, but grouping by division in Round 1 is recommended. After Round 1 players must be sorted and grouped by division and score.	
	Players may be grouped in fivesomes, but recommended group size is foursomes.

Amateur Payout Model	True Amateur model recommended where bulk of Amateur payout value is in their player packages. If True Amateur payout not used than Top 25%+ each division to be paid.
Live scoring	Live scoring for each round of the event is required of A tiers and expected of B tiers. If live scoring is offered, use of UDisc or DiscGolfMetrix is required.
Upload Scores to pdga.com via Tournament Manager	Before end of each competition day
Submit completed TD Report to PDGA	Upload final report to pdga.com using Tournament Manager within 48 hours of event completion
Event Financial Report to PDGA Europe	Within 3 weeks of event completion
Event Website	Url provided by January 1 for inclusion in PDGA Tour schedule listing. Ready to handle event registration when opens. Lists of registered players updated weekly and duplicated at pdga.com event page. Course map and event scorecard posted 2 weeks prior to event. PDGA EuroTour logo displayed.
Registration	Registration opens minimum 3 months prior to event. Phase 1 (2 weeks): MPO 980+ FPO 880+ MP40 930+ FP40 830+ MPG 900+ MPS 880+ MA1 900+ FA1 800+ MJ18 880+ FJ18 750+. Phase 2 (4 weeks) thresholds 60 ratings points below Phase 1. A minimum of 15% of event spots must be reserved for female players thru end Phase 2. Wildcards: TDs may reserve up to 12 A Tier or 8 B Tier spots for Wildcards, to accommodate touring pros, event sponsors, women etc. Phase 3 open to players not qualifying under Phases 1 & 2. Entry fee must be paid at registration. Waitlist in order application/payment received, can only be on waitlist as of phase in which player qualifies. All registration closes 1 week prior to event.
Video coverage	Live or post-produced video coverage of the event is recommended.
Post Event Article with	Published by PDGA Europe within 72 hours of event completion
Points/Bonus System	Points per Division per 2018 EPT (MPO/FPO) / ET (other divisions) points tables except A tier points = 1.5 X B tier points. Player counts up to top 5 event finishes in actual division(s) played. From EUR 5 per player fees: EUR 4 per player to division bonus. EUR 1 per player distributed to division bonuses as determined by PDGA Europe. Sanction fees used for trophies (minimum Top3 MPO/FPO, minimum 1 other divisions).
Points Standings	Update by PDGA Europe within 72 hours of each event completion

Other Requirements	Signed player waiver holding event organizers and PDGA harmless. Dress code (per Competition Manual 3.04). Spotters on potentially problematic holes. PDGA banner(s) prominently displayed. Photos provided by event to PDGA Europe where PDGA Europe representative not in attendance.
Other Recommendation	Caddie book. No smoking on course during play policy. No alcohol/drugs by players/caddies/staff until event completed. Seating for players at tees. Distance markers on long holes. Water divers. Event insurance policy. PDGA Europe logo on event merchandise/discs.
